

August 2, 2022 Primary Election

ABSENTEE BALLOTS AVAILABLE

Absentee ballots and ballot applications for the August 2, 2022, Primary Election are now available at the Courthouse Monday – Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm. Voting is also available during the lunch hour 12 – 1:00 pm by appointment. Saturday voting will be available at the courthouse on July 30, 2022, from 8:00 am till 12:00 noon.

REMINDER - This is a Primary Election so you will be asked to choose a party ballot (Rep, Dem, Constitution & Libertarian.

Not all county races appear on every ballot. Check our election website daviesscountymo.gov to see sample ballots or call the office for more info.

You may vote without having your return envelope notarized if you fall into this category:

- **#2** Incapacity or confinement to home due to any illness and/or a permanent disability (your caregiver is also eligible)

You may vote an absentee ballot by mail if you are prevented from going to the polls for any of the following reasons. Your envelope must be notarized if mailed or returned by an eligible relative; or it can be returned unnotarized to the courthouse in person by the voter so the envelope can be certified by election staff.

- **#1** Away from your home polling location on election day
- **#3** Religious belief or practice
- **#4** Employment by an election authority at a location other than your home polling location
- **#5** Incarceration
- **#6** Certified participation in the address confidentiality program, Safe at Home

The last day to mail out an absentee ballot for this election is July 20, 2022, at 5:00 pm, so get your applications in early. Absentee voting will still be available in person at the courthouse until Monday, August 1st at 5:00 pm.
