

ABSENTEE BALLOTS AVAILABLE

Absentee ballots for the April 8, 2025, General Municipal Election will be available to be voted at the Courthouse Monday – Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. beginning February 25, 2025. In-person voting will also be available by appointment during the 12 – 1:00 pm lunch hour. Saturday voting will be available at the courthouse on April 5, 2025, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

REMINDER

**This is a General Municipal Election therefore many voters
may not have any races to vote on.**

Stop by or call the Clerk's office for an absentee ballot application.

Qualifying reasons for voting absentee:

- #1 Away from your home on election day (work or pleasure)
- #2 Incapacity or confinement due to illness or physical disability on election day, including caring for a person who is incapacitated or confined due to illness or disability and resides at the same address
- #3 Religious belief or practice
- #4 Employment by an election authority at a location other than your home polling place
- #5 Incarceration, although I have retained all the necessary qualifications for voting
- #6 Certified participation in the address confidentiality program, Safe at Home

No Excuse Absentee Voting:

Starts March 25th, 2 Weeks prior to Election Day in person NO EXCUSE absentee voting is available at the County Clerk's office.

- **The last day to request an absentee ballot by mail is March 26th, 2025, until 5:00 p.m.**

***In order to vote in the April 8, 2025, General Municipal Election, a voter must be registered in their county of residence by March 12th, 2025.**
