# This is a General Municipal Election therefore many voters may not have any races to vote on.

## Qualifying reasons for voting absentee:

- #1 Away from your home on election day (work or pleasure)
- #2 Incapacity or confinement due to illness or physical disability on election day, including caring for a person who is incapacitated or confined due to illness or disability and resides at the same address
- #3 Religious belief or practice
- #4 Employment by an election authority at a location other than your home polling place
- #5 Incarceration, although I have retained all the necessary qualifications for voting
- #6 Certified participation in the address confidentiality program, Safe at Home

## **No Excuse Absentee Voting:**

Starts March 25th, 2 Weeks prior to Election Day in person NO EXCUSE absentee voting is available at the County Clerk's office.

• The last day to request an absentee ballot by mail is March 26th, 2025, until 5:00 p.m.
