If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.3800 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property. ABSENTEE BALLOTS AVAILABLE

Absentee ballots for the April 5, 2022 General Municipal Election will be available to be voted at the Courthouse Monday - Friday, 8:00 am to 4:30 pm beginning February 22, 2022. In person voting will also be available during the lunch hour 12 - 1:00 pm by appointment. Saturday voting will be available at the courthouse on April 2, 2022 from 8:00 am till 12:00 noon.

REMINDER

This is a General Municipal Election where many voters may not have any races to vote on. Check our county website www.daviesscountymo.gov to view the Combined Ballot or call the office for more info. Stop by or call the Clerk’s office for an absentee ballot application.

You may vote without having your return envelope notarized if you fall into the following category. Please call the County Clerk’s office if you are unsure if you qualify for this reason. Many people do qualify.

• #2 Incapacity or confinement due to a current illness or disability (and your caregiver is also eligible)

You may also vote absentee if you are prevented from going to the polls for any of the following reasons. Envelope must be notarized or returned to the courthouse in person so it can be certified.

• #1 Away from your home on election day (work or pleasure)

• #3 Religious belief or practice

• #4 Employment by an election authority at a location other than your home polling place

• #5 Incarceration

• #6 Certified participation in the address confidentiality program, Safe at Home

The last day to mail out an absentee ballot for this election is March 23, 2022 at 5:00 pm. Absentee voting will still be available in person at the courthouse until Monday, April 4th at 5:00 pm.
